Get to know Big Buford at new **Rally's** in Corona

Inland diners now have two Rally's restaurants to visit along the 60 Freeway.

A new location opened Thursday at 1406 Sixth St., Corona, 30 miles west of the Rally's at 12721 Moreno Beach Drive, Moreno Valley.

The new store is a full-fledged restaurant with a drive-through and a large dining room. The one in Moreno Valley is inside a Walmart Supercenter.

Franchisee Malik Hashim took over an existing building in the The Plaza on Sixth Street. It was once occupied by Arby's, giving him more seating inside most Rally's, which do a lot of drive-through business.

The Florida quick-service chain is getting more familiar in Southern California, Hashim said, although it is not a large presence in the Inland Empire.

Rally's and its sister chain, Checkers, are known for their Big Buford double-patty burger as well as their fries. Hashim said Rally's recently expanded its sweets menu, which includes milkshakes and soft serve ice cream concoctions called Stackers with layers of sauces, candies and cookies.

Hashim said he plans a total of four restaurants in the Inland Empire, [including a prefabricated building in San Bernardino](#).
